SITE VISIT AND CLARIFICATION MEETING</li> <li>Is the bidder obliged to go through the construction site and in his offer attach a certificate of site visit?</li> <li>Will the offer be rejected if the bidder representative did not attend the scheduled site visit and clarification meeting?</li> </ul>	As clearly indicated in the Instructions to tenderers, the tenderer is obliged to visit and inspect the site of the works and its surroundings. Companies who did not perform the site visit are not allowed to submit their bids as sole bidders or Leader of consortium.
2.	We have noticed that demanding Technical and professional capacity of candidate is not clearly defined. Therefore, we kindly ask you to clarify what the phrase "with a portion of the contract being at least 1.500.000 EUR" actually means. Does it mean that the minimum value of each contract should be EUR 1.500.000 or the total value of two contracts should be EUR 1.500.000?	The minimum value of each contract should be EUR 1.500.000.
