Please read carefully Article 11 of the Contract Notice on the instructions on eligibility of candidates.</p> <p>As given in the first page of the Application form (referred to in Article 24 of the Contract notice) "Applications submitted by a consortium (i.e. either a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping set up informally for a specific tender procedure) must follow the instructions applicable to the consortium leader and its members." This instruction shall be followed when filling in the Application form.</p> |
