

1.	<p>We are compiling the list of applicant's experience (2.1.7. of the application form) and we have a problem of choosing appropriate sectors for individual projects (classification under 3.2.2 of the application form). Majority of projects our organization has implemented focused on the production of investigative journalism content published online (primarily on our website - online medium). We are a non-profit NGO which operates as a medium.</p> <p>It would seem logical to thus choose 22 Communications, but there is no sub-sector involving online media (there is only 22030 Radio/Television/Print Media). The other sub-sectors under Communications do not match our activities. As far as we could identify other sectors that could match our activities, these are maybe 15163 Free Flow of Information, 15150 Strengthening civil society or 92010 Support to national NGOs?</p>	<p>All sectors that refer to media in general are relevant no matter if it is online, print or electronic media.</p>
2.	<p>In the folder 'Annexes to be completed' there are three types of LEFs (for individuals, private companies and public entities) none of which seems to be suitable for our organization as it is a non-profit NGO.
