#### 7. Contract description:

The contract is aimed to contribute to the protection of consumer rights and interests in Serbia in accordance with the EU 'acquis'. The technical assistance would be expected to assist the Ministry of Trade and Services (MTS) in further alignment of the Serbian consumer protection legal framework with the EU 'acquis', to enhance the institutional capacity for enforcement of the consumer protection legislation of the MTS, out-of-court dispute settlement bodies, the courts, consumer organisations and other relevant authorities, to strengthen the cooperation and coordination among public institutions and private bodies involved in consumer protection and to increase the awareness on consumer protection policy among various stakeholders.

#### 8. Numbers and titles of lots:

The contract is divided into lots: no, 1 lot only.

9. Budget:

Maximum budget: 2 500 000 EUR.

#### 10. Scope for additional services:

The contracting authority may, at its own discretion, extend the project in duration and/or scope, subject to the availability of funding, up to a maximum not exceeding the length and value of the initial contract. Any extension of the contract would be subject to satisfactory performance by the contractor.

Participation is open to all legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of candidates) which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see also item 29 below). Participation is also open to international organisations. The participation of natural persons is governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

# 12. Candidature:

All eligible natural and legal persons (as per item 11 above) or groupings of such persons (consortia) may apply. A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e., the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the contracting authority.

The participation of an ineligible natural or legal person (as per item 11) will result in the automatic exclusion of that person. In particular, if that ineligible person belongs to a consortium, the whole consortium will be excluded.

# 13. Number of applications:

No more than 1 application can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting an application). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than 1 application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.

# 14. Shortlist alliances prohibited:

Any tenders received from tenderers comprising firms other than those mentioned in the shortlisted application forms will be excluded from this restricted tender procedure. Shortlisted candidates may not form alliances or subcontract to each other for the contract in question.

## 15. Grounds for exclusion:

As part of the application form, candidates must submit a signed declaration, included in the standard application form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3 of the 'Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions'.

## 16. Subcontracting:

Subcontracting is allowed.

Maximum percentage of the contract value which may be subcontracted: 10 %.

## 17. Number of candidates to be shortlisted:

On the basis of the applications received, at least 4 and at most 8 candidates will be invited to submit detailed tenders for this contract. If the number of eligible candidates meeting the selection criteria is less than the minimum of 4, the contracting authority may invite the candidates who satisfy the criteria to submit a tender.

## Selection and award criteria

## 21. Selection criteria:

Same criteria for legal and natural person.

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

1) Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

In the case of the applicant being a public body equivalent information should be provided:

1. the average annual turnover of the candidate in the last 3 years (2007, 2008 and 2009) must exceed 2 000 000 EUR.

2) Professional capacity of candidate:

1. at least 10 of the staff working for the candidate currently work in fields related to this contract.

3) Technical capacity of candidate:

1. the candidate shall, within the 3-year period prior to the closing date of submission of the application, have completed (i.e., final report approved) at least 2 projects with the candidate's proportion equivalent or more than 600 000 EUR for each of the projects, in the following fields of expertise:

i. assistance in supporting institutional reforms in the consumer protection sector including capacity building activities for consumer protection authorities and/or consumer NGOs;

ii. assistance in enforcement of consumer protection legislative framework in accordance with the EU 'acquis'; altogether the reference projects should cover both areas of expertise.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the contracting authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator.

If more than 8 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates must be re-examined to identify the 8 best applications for the tender procedure. The only factors which will be taken into consideration during this re-examination are: higher number of projects, which meet the requirements set in criterion 21.3);

higher total numerical value of the proportion carried out by the candidate of the projects identified as relevant as per criterion 21.3 after having applied the first additional criterion mentioned above.
