In the Technical specification for Lot 1 you require that all vehicles must have an engine with EURO 4 standard Since an act stipulating that only EURO 5 or higher standard vehicles may be registered will come into effect in Europe in January 1st 5. See reply to question no. 4. 2011, and since the delivery of vehicles for this tender will most probably occur in 2011, we would like to know whether a bid with EURO 5 or higher standard vehicles would be acceptable to you.
