1.	<p>In the Procurement Notice, section <b><u>Selection and award criteria – point 21 Selection criteria, point 3) Technical capacity of candidate</u></b> it is said:</p> <p>»1. the candidate has successfully completed (i.e. the final report has been approved) within the 3-year period prior to the deadline for receipt of applications at least 2 projects with the budget of at least 500 000 EUR (the proportion carried out by the candidate will be taken into consideration) in the specific field of expertise described in the above Article 7.«</p> <p>Does this mean that:</p> <p>1) every member of a consortium should have had a part in previous businesses that was worth 500.000 EUR or only main provider?</p> <p>2) the entire business had a budget of 500.000 EUR, and members of a consortium had taken one part/proportion of this budget?</p>	<p>1) Second paragraph of the same point 21 stipulates 'In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole'.</p> <p>It is not required that every member of a consortium fulfills selection criteria. Capacity of a consortium as a whole will be taken into consideration.</p> <p>2) Each of the minimum 2 required projects must have a budget of at least 500,000.00 EUR.</p> <p>The indicated minimum amount of at least 500,000.00 EUR for a project relates to the proportion a legal entity has carried out in this project.</p> <p>In the standard application form to be submitted, in the point 6, for each of the referenced projects the overall project value as well as the proportion carried out by legal entity (in %) shall be indicated.</p> <p>Example: for the indicated overall project value of 3,000,000.00 EUR and 25% as the proportion carried out by legal entity, the value of 750,000.00 EUR would be taken into consideration for this legal entity.</p>
