| 1. | <p>Related to the Procurement Notice of the abovementioned tender, in item 21.3) Technical capacity it is requested that "the candidate has carried out in the course of the past 3 years (starting from 1.1.2009)" at least 2 projects in the field related to this contract.</p> <p>This means that the candidates can submit references for the projects:</p> <p>a) <u>started before 01.01.2009 but ended in the course of the last 3 years</u>; (because some of the projects lasts more than 3 years)</p> <p>b) <u>started after 01.01.2009 and closed before 31.12.2011</u>; (usually companies are not limited for the beginning of the project, but to the end of the project), or</p> <p>c) <u>started after 01.01.2009 but not ended in the course of the last 3 years</u> (but the amount spent up to the date of submission of tenders can be assumed as work carried out and where it will be confirmed by the relevant Contracting authority)</p> | <p>Please note that it is possible for the candidate/tenderer to refer to a part of a project where the contract is not yet finished, but then, only the part which is successfully completed may be used as reference. The candidate/tenderer, when requested, needs to be able to submit documentary evidence of this part's successful completion (e.g. statement from the entity which ordered the service). If a candidate/tenderer has implemented the project in a consortium, it should be clear from the documentary evidence the percentage the candidate has successfully completed (Practical Guide 2.4.11.1.3).</p> <p>Please also refer to the answers provided in the previous Contracting authority's clarifications no. 1 and no. 2.</p> |
