No	Question	Answer
1.	LOT 1: Is it possible to deliver basic furniture / house equipment to families moving in prefabricated houses	Yes, delivery of basic furniture (one bed per family member, kitchen table and one chair per family member, cooker, refrigerator and kitchen cabinets with sink) is in line with the Guidelines for Applicants.
2.	LOT 2: It is mentioned that the project will provide various return assistance to 200 families. How many of these 200 families could as well receive, upon needs assessment, an individual economic grant?	As per the Guidelines for Applicants, the foreseen activities are defined as: <i>Provide support for starting up a small business or agriculture-oriented income generation based on returnee community assessment needs;</i> Nevertheless upon needs assessment and in agreement with the Beneficiary Institution income generation based activities can be supported to individual return families.
3.	In regard to the Types of activities in LOT 1 – Closure of CC – Guidelines page 13 : “Procure and deliver materials intended for the establishment of prefabricated houses”, question is if the installation of prefabricated houses is eligible activity	The installation of prefabricated houses is in line with the guidelines for Applicants and it is considered a mandatory activity for this component.
4.	In regard to the Types of activities in LOT 1 – Closure of CC – Guidelines page 13: “Construction of housing units providing housing	With reference to the mentioned paragraph, please note that purchasing in this case refers to the application of the Law on refugees which

5.	<p>Could you please clarify if the provision of housing solutions for the certain percentage of extremely vulnerable domicile population from the target municipalities would be an eligible action within the LOT 1 actions.</p>	<p>The provision of housing solutions to extremely vulnerable population is usually allowed up to 20%.</p>
6.	<p>Could you please clarify if the provision of housing solutions for returnees accommodated in CC would be an eligible action within the LOT 1 actions.</p>	<p>In line with section 2.2.4, in order to ensure equal treatment of applicants, the Contracting Authority cannot give a prior opinion on the eligibility of applicants, or affiliated entity(ies), an action or specific activities</p>
7.	<p>Could you please clarify if the provision of basic furniture for the prefabricated houses and apartments would be an eligible activity under the LOT 1.</p>	<p>Please refer to answer no. 1</p>
