The Contracting Authority is not in a position to provide preliminary opinion in any potential conflict of interest or unfair advantage issues. Any potential conflict of interest or unfair advantage issues will be analysed on a case by case basis by the appointed Evaluation Committee for each tender procedure. As a general guidance, please read carefully Section 2.3.6 of the Practical Guide to contract procedures for European Union external actions (PRAG), paying special attention to the following sentence: "For instance, any firm or expert involved in preparing a project (e.g. drafting the Terms of Reference) must, as a rule, be excluded from tendering for services that are based on those preparations, unless they can prove to the Contracting Authority that their initial involvement does not constitute unfair competition."
